- Dine with a group of middle school girls each day sharing your insights on high school, what has worked well for you. You are in essence their "big sister" for the week.
- Engage with the girls throughout the day with a positive attitude.
- Share your "big sister" advice and insight to them.
- Help with craft projects
- Take photographs each day that we can include in the nightly update to parents.
- Help to lead hands on team building and leadership activities with the lead teacher.
